Epirocs BenchREMOTE operator station is now also available for SmartROC T45 LF, SmartROC C50 and SmartROC CL.

With the BenchREMOTE you can simultaneously remotely control up to three Epiroc Smart surface drill rigs from a distance of up to 100 meters. The BenchREMOTE can be installed in a customer-supplied vehicle, trailer or in a container. As before, BenchREMOTE is also available for SmartROC D50, SmartROC D55, and SmartROC D60, and SmartROC D65.
